

## ***“Kiddie Klan” Exercise***

**Objective:** To use a visual image to inspire discussion about race relations

**Audience:** High school students and adults

**Materials Needed:** A large copy of the photo (or photo can be projected), copies of discussion questions, and writing utensils

**Time Required:** 30 – 60 minutes depending on length of discussion

**Teacher Instructions:** To begin, distribute copies of the following “Kiddie Klan” writing prompts. Next, distribute copies of the picture of “Josh” (or project the image). Give students 15 minutes to individually answer the questions on their handouts. Once students have finished answering the questions, use the “Kiddie Klan” handout as discussion questions to lead the class in a discussion of their answers.
